

Kiss Me Washcloth

Crocheted washcloths make for great personal gifts! This washcloth features a textured side, great for exfoliating; and a smooth side, great for finishing.

Materials:

I-9, 5.5mm Crochet Hook
Approx ½ skein of Plymouth Yarn
“Jeanne” cotton/acrylic
Tapestry Needle



Stitch Abbreviations:

BLO: Back Loop Only
Ch: Chain
FLO: Front Loop Only
KS: Kiss Stitch
Sc: Single Crochet
SL: Slip Stitch
YO: Yarn Over

Special Stitch Instructions:

Kiss Stitch: Insert hook into BLO of designated stitch, YO and pull up loop, insert hook (from front to back) in FLO of SAME stitch, YO and pull up loop, YO and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

Gauge: 4 KS = 1”; 4 rows = 1”

Instructions:

Ch 31

Row 1: In 2nd ch from hook sc, sc in each ch across. (30 sts)

Row 2: Ch 1, turn work, KS in 1st st, and in each st across. (30 sts)

Row 3: Ch 1, turn work, sc in 1st st, and in each st across. (30 sts)

Repeat Rows 2 & 3 until work measures 7 ¼”.

Edge: Sc around work, ensuring 3 sc sts are in each corner, join with sl st, finish off.
